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1. Introduction

Thank you for purchasing Transcend's Slim Portable DVD Writer. This slim, elegant high-speed portable DVD writer is perfect for playing, backing up your vital data and discs. With its slim easy-to-carry size and advanced high-speed media writing capabilities, the DVD Writer is ideal for playing movies, installing software, or backing up your files, documents, photos, music and videos when using a compact notebook computer or notebook. In addition, the DVD Writer comes with a full-version of CyberLink Media Suite 10* software that lets you easily create your own DVD. This User's Manual is designed to help you get the most from your new device. Please read it in detail before using the DVD Writer.

3. Safety Precautions

General Use

- During operation, avoid exposing your DVD writer to extreme temperatures above 40°C or below 5°C.
- Never drop your DVD Writer.
- Only use the DVD Writer face-up, on a stable flat surface
- Do not allow your DVD Writer to come in contact with water or any other liquids.
- Do not use a damp/wet cloth to wipe or clean the exterior case.
- Never look directly into the laser lens, as it can be harmful to your eyes.
- Do not attempt to open the outer case (doing so will void your product warranty).
- Never touch the laser lens.



■ Writing Data

- Do not touch, pick up, or move the DVD Writer during the write process. This can damage the device and will cause errors on the disc being written.
- Transcend does not take any responsibility for data loss or damage resulting
 from use of this product. If using this product to backup data, we strongly advise
 using high-quality recordable media, and that you fully test and verify the contents
 of all written discs. It is also a good idea to regularly backup important data to a
 different computer or other storage medium.
- To ensure High-Speed USB 2.0 data transfer rates when using your DVD Writer with a computer, please check that the computer has the relevant USB drivers. If you are unsure about how to check this, please consult the computer or motherboard User's Manual for USB driver information.
- Only use the USB cable that came with the DVD Writer to connect it to a computer, and always ensure that the cable is in good condition. NEVER use a cable that is frayed or damaged.
 - Ensure nothing is resting on the USB cable and that the cable is not located where it can be tripped over or stepped on.






5. Using the DVD writer

Connecting the DVD Writer

- 1. Plug the small end of the USB Cable into the Mini USB port on the DVD Writer.
- 2. Plug the large end of the cable into the available USB port on your desktop computer or notebook.




Note: Please be sure to connect the DVD Writer using the provided USB Cable.




■ Inserting a Disc


1. Press the Eject Button on the front of the DVD Writer to release the disc tray.



2. Place a disc onto the tray.



3. Push the disc tray back into the DVD Writer. When completely closed, the LED indicator will flash.




■ Ejecting a Disc



NEVER disconnect the DVD Writer from a Computer when the disc is spinning.

For Windows users


- 1. Press the Eject Button on the front of the DVD Writer to release the disc tray.
- 2. Place your thumb on the spindle and use your other fingers to gently pry the disc upwards until it pops free.





For Mac users

- 1. Click the Finder icon in the Dock to open a Finder window
- 2. In the Finder sidebar, click the Eject button to eject the disc.



6. <u>Using TV Connectivity</u>

- 1. Connect the DVD Writer to your TV. Turn on the TV power.
- 2. Open the disc tray and place a disc.
- **3.** Press the Eject button for 2 seconds. The LED will be solid green. Now it's TV Connectivity mode. (When you do again, the function will be OFF. LED turns OFF)
- **4.** Close the disc tray to play the disc.

Note: The DVD Writer does not support playing copyright-protected (DRM) CD/DVD when connected to a TV.

7. Software Download

Make sure that the DVD writer is connected to your computer before installing:

- Download the CyberLink Media Suite 10 from Transcend's Download Center at https://www.transcend-info.com/Support/No-399
- Double click on the CyberLink_Media_Suite_Downloader executable file you have downloaded.
- **3. CyberLink.Media.Suite.10.exe** will be downloaded to a temporary directory. Double click on the file to run the setup program.
- **4.** Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation process.

Note: CyberLink Media Suite 10 can only be installed in Windows[®] 7/8/10.

8. Frequently Asked Questions

If a problem occurs with your DVD Writer, please check the information listed below before sending your DVD Writer in for repair. If you are unable to remedy a problem after trying the following suggestions, please consult your dealer, service center, or local Transcend branch office. We also have FAQ and Support services on our website at https://www.transcend-info.com/support/service

Operating system cannot detect the DVD Writer

Check the following:

- 1. Is your DVD Writer properly connected to the USB port? If not, unplug it and plug it in again. If it is properly connected, try using another available USB port.
- 2. Are you using the USB cable that came in the DVD Writer package? If not, try using the Transcend-supplied USB cable to connect the DVD Writer to your computer.

• The DVD Writer does not Power On (LED does not flash)

Check the following:

- 1. Ensure that the DVD Writer is properly connected to the USB port on your computer.
- **2.** Ensure that the USB port is working properly. If not, try using an alternate USB port.

• The DVD Writer Cannot Read a Disc

The disc may be dirty, scratched or damaged. Try cleaning the disc with water or a DVD cleaning solution.

Writing to a Blank Disc Fails

In most cases, this problem is a result of trying to write to poor quality recordable media. For best results, please use only retail-packaged name brand recordable discs.

9. Recycling & Environmental Considerations
